

BASEBALL HOLD-ALL

- 1 - 1 x 6 x 12" Back
- 1 - 1 x 4 x 12" Rack
- 1 - 1 x 2 x 12" Support
- 2 - 3/8" x 4" Dowel Pegs



1. Drill 1" holes centered 1 1/2" and 5" from one end of 1 x 4
2. At other end of 1 x 4 measure across the face and mark 1 1/4" and 2 3/4".
Using a coping saw or jigsaw, cut the wood out between these two marks, making a curved slot 5" long. (See illustration below.)
I made a template for the kids to use for this step.
3. Glue and nail (use 4d finish nails) the 1x2 support piece to the rack.
Attach it to the side that has 1 1/4" left beside the slot..
4. Glue and nail (use 6d finish nails) the rack to the bottom edge of the 1x6 back piece.
5. Drill two 3/8" holes 1" down and directly under the two holes you drilled in the rack.
Drill through the support and the back.
6. Glue the dowel pegs in the holes you just drilled
7. Attach picture hanging hardware to hang your holder.
