

Clatter Blocks

Amaze your friends with the toy that never stops falling.

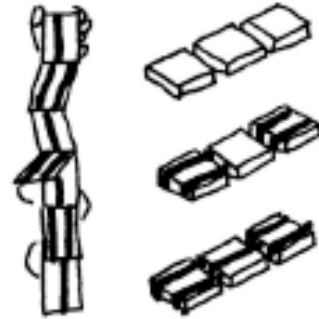
Materials:

24 x 3 x ¼" strip of wood

3 – ½" 36" cloth tape or heavy ribbon

stapler or glue

Sandpaper



Cut the strip of wood into eight 3" squares. You will need 6 or 7, so this gives you extra in case you should split one. Sand all the edges. Lay six or seven blocks end to end on the table, leaving about ¼" of space between the blocks. Weave the two outer tapes around the blocks, stapling or gluing the tape to the top end of each block as shown. Next, weave the center tape through the line of blocks in the reverse direction and staple or glue to the bottom of the blocks as shown.

(This is a good project for Tiger Cubs and Adult Partners. Just have an Adult Partner pre-cut enough wood before the den meeting)
