

Huck Finn's Log Raft

Materials: 11 twigs of equal thickness, liquid white glue, 1 sheet of white paper, colored crayons or markers, wax paper.

Cut twigs a little longer than logs shown in illustration. Place six twigs on sheet of wax paper. Glue the twigs together with glue to form raft. Cut two twigs to fit the width of the six glued twigs. Glue these two twigs near the ends of the raft. Let the raft dry overnight. When dry turn upside down.

Cut a twig to form the mast and glue it standing up to the center of the raft. Cut a twig to form the last two twigs to fit the width of the raft. Glue the remaining two twigs to both sides of the mast. Dry overnight. Cut the sail from white paper, decorate. Push sail through standing twig.
