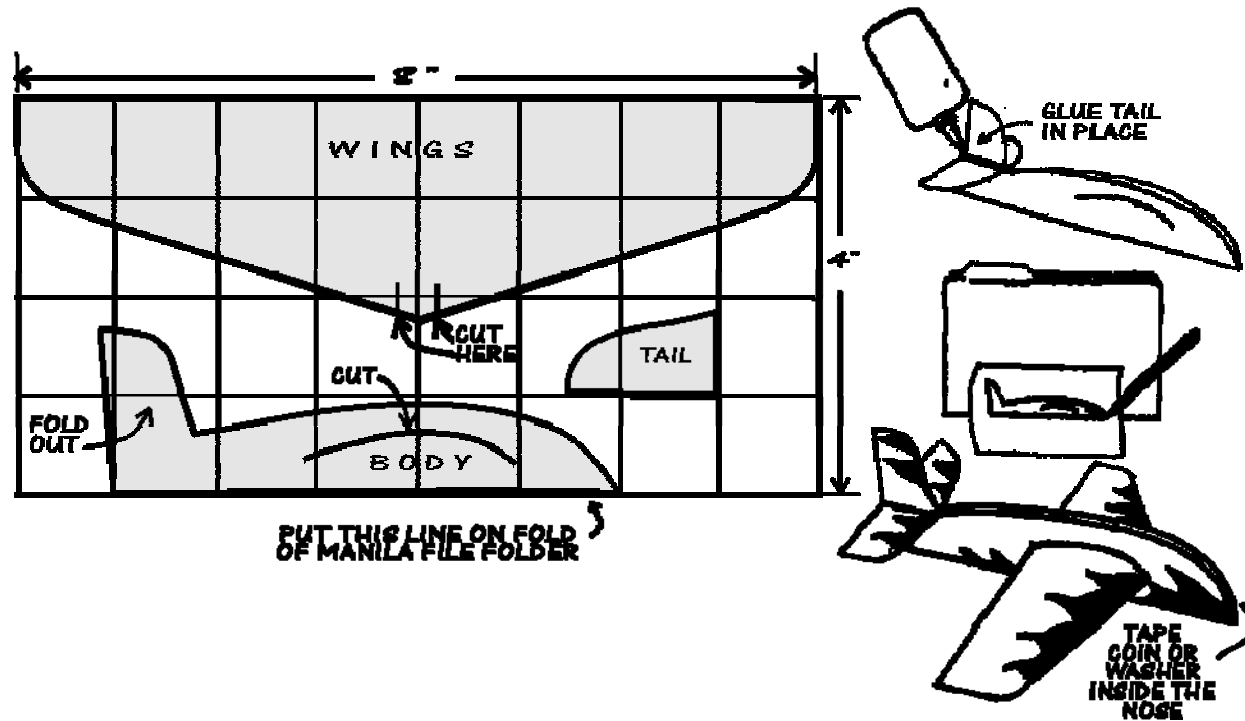


## Manila File Folder "Glider"



Enlarge patterns by the grid method so that the wing is about eight inches, the fuselage five inches. Trace patterns on manila file folder; put fuselage on fold so that it will be doubled. Cut out with shears or utility knife. Put tail piece all the way down between rear wings and tape or glue in place. Fold out rear wings. Slip big wing into fuselage. Cut and slide forward until wing cuts fit into fuselage. Glue or tape coin or small washer inside nose. Decorate with acrylic paint or marking pens. If glider sinks, try a smaller coin or washer in the nose and bend up rear wings slightly.
